Visitors Information

Dress code -

The dress code is smart casual, golf shoes must be worn on the course. Shirts must be tucked in. No jeans are allowed on the golf course, and shirts must have a collar. Football tops are not allowed.

Car parking

Visitors are requested to use the overflow Car Park signed for visitors.

Golf

Pace of play guidelines are as follows:

- 2 ball 3 hours
- 3 ball 3 hours 20 minutes
- 4 ball 3 hours 40 minutes.

Please keep up with the group ahead and call fast groups through.

Golfers must repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.

Greenstaff

Our staff working on the course have priority, please wait for them to wave and indicate its safe to play.

Trolleys

Electric trolleys must have winter wheels from November to March. Please note that hedgehog style wheels will not be permitted.

Trolleys are not permitted on the tees or withing 3 meters of the greens.

Buggies

Buggies can be hired from the professional shop. We advise pre booking these to avoid disappointment **Visitors are not allowed to use personal buggies at NGC.**

Catering

Breakfast is available from 8am every day. the kitchen closes at 15:00 in the winter, 16:00 in the summer. Fridays – Sunday in the summer it will be open until 18:00.

Groups of more than 8 are advised to prebook food to avoid long waits.

Halfway house
